DEIS stands for Delivering Equality of Opportunity in Schools. It is a national programme, aimed at addressing the educational needs of young people. It is monitored on a continuous basis by a team of teachers called the DEIS Team and Mr. O'Mahony & Ms. Fogarty coordinate this team of teachers. The DEIS Team has come up with actions (ideas, projects), to help the school meet these targets. At the end of each academic year a summary will be made available for parents to view these targets and how we as a school plan at attain them.
